# **Getting started**

- 1. Connect the bundled Type-C® cable to your keyboard.
- 2. Connect your keyboard to the PC.
- 3. Download and install the Armoury Crate software from

- 4. Follow the software instructions to update your keyboard's firmware.
- 5. Customize your keyboard using Armoury Crate.

# Setting up a wireless keyboard

- 1. Remove the wireless dongle from the keyboard.
- 2. Insert the wireless dongle to a USB port on the PC.
- 3. Set the power switch to ON.

# **Battery Status**

The RGB indicator on your gaming keyboard will turn red (breathing) and the LEDs for all the other keys will switch off when the battery power is below 20% in wireless mode. You may charge your gaming keyboard by using the bundled USB cable.
